

Notice of Changes to Visitation Restrictions

Effective Monday, April 15, 2024, Koga Hospital 21 will lift the visitor restrictions previously implemented to prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus. Under the new guidelines, we are pleased to welcome visitors back to our facilities.

Guidelines for Visitors

- Please assist us in maintaining a safe environment by wearing a surgical mask and using hand sanitizer during your visit.
- Visitors are encouraged to use either the conversation room or a private room.
※For those with mobility issues, visits can be conducted in the patient's room and are limited to approximately 15 minutes.
- If you are exhibiting symptoms such as fever or cold-like symptoms, we ask that you postpone your visit to protect the health of our patients and staff.
- As a general safety measure, we request that children below middle school age not visit at this time to ensure their safety and that of our patients.
